

Active Brother Scholarships



With the re-boot and expansion of our chapter here at UNCC, we look to the future of our historic property off East Mallard Creek Church Road. This property has been a staple in many student's lives at UNC Charlotte; providing memories, experiences, and new friendships that last a lifetime. With the plaguing difficulties within Greek Life throughout the country, the Alumni Board has been researching ways to make the current chapter house a safer and more functional home for future Chi Phi generations. With the help of other Chi Phi Chapters and our current Alumni, we will be able to put procedures in place to allow the Psi Delta Chapter to be a long-standing member of Fraternity Life at UNC Charlotte.

Additional information will be forthcoming as the various suggestions and ideas regarding the renovations of our current chapter house are reviewed. One option that has been suggested is the potential construction of a new structure to create an environment similar to other fraternity houses. This will include smaller bedrooms, larger common areas, a larger commercial kitchen, community bathrooms and areas where active members can blow off steam or study for an upcoming test. Conceptual layouts are shown to meet Charlotte parking requirements and to maintain both existing entrances onto East Mallard Creek Church Road. These options would allow for multiple property amenities such as the sand volleyball and basketball courts for our new active members to enjoy.



As we settle back in the chapter house for the 2019-2020 school year, we will be able to assist our new active brothers in making smart decisions and contributing to the UNC Charlotte Greek Life legacy that we helped establish in the early 1970's. With limited development opportunities adjacent to the University, we are optimistic in keeping our off-campus property a place where the active brothers and alumni can come together and represent the University by showing the true meaning of brotherhood, providing philanthropy services to the community, and achieving academic excellence.
